Waubonsee Community College seeks a full-time, tenure-track Sociology Instructor with a demonstrated commitment to teaching excellence, diversity, equity and holistic student success to deliver a broad range of courses within the Sociology (SOC) curricular portfolio.

The ideal candidate will be responsible for teaching two to three sections of SOC 100: Introduction to Sociology courses per semester, with the knowledge and experience to deliver SOC 120: Racial and Ethnic Relations, SOC 130: Sociology of Family and SOC 240: Sociology of Deviance. The candidate will demonstrate commitment to an interdisciplinary focus, experience with innovative learning strategies, the ability to enhance the success of diverse student populations, and the ability to effectively use instructional and classroom technology to enhance teaching and learning.

Duties and expectations include, but are not limited to:

- Designing syllabi, lessons, activities, assignments, and assessments to address different learning styles and to ensure that students successfully meet course objectives and outcomes.
- Incorporating learning-centered principles and concepts and motivating students to participate actively in all aspects of the educational experience.
- Demonstrating commitment to continuous improvement and ongoing professional growth.
- Working collaboratively with colleagues throughout the college to achieve equitable outcomes for all students and to serve the needs of students and community.
